Ibuprofen 400 mg .

Disp. \#30
(Thirty)
Take 1 tablet 4 times a day to help reduce post-operative inflammation (pain and swelling).

REFILL $\qquad$ TIMES

DDS

Disp. 1 Pint
( 480 ml )
Rinse for 30 seconds with $1 / 2$ to 1 ounce three times a day, until all gone. (Start this medication the day after surgery.)

## Amoxicillin 500 mg.

Disp. \#28
(Twenty-Eight)
Take 1 antibiotic tablet every 6 hours until they are all gone. (Start this medication within 24 hrs. after surgery; antibiotics may decrease the effectiveness of birth control pills.)

Sublingual Tabs

Disp. \#5
(Five)
Place 1 on tongue every 8 hours as needed for nausea, and let dissolve. (If nausea persists for more than 12 hours, contact Dr. Payne.)
